

RENAMING CAPULONG STREET TRAVERSING THE CITY OF MANILA AS
SALVADOR MARIÑO STREET

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This proposed measure seeks to pay tribute to the life that the Honorable Salvador L. Mariño has lived in service to the people. From 1958 to 1961, he served in the Fourth Congress of the Philippines as the Representative for the First District of the City of Manila. The year after, he acted as the Executive Secretary for then President Diosdado Macapagal, who then later appointed him as the Secretary for the Department of Justice.

Currently, Calle Capulong is an important thoroughfare for Tondo, Manila, which also forms part of Circumferential Road 2. If passed, this bill will rename Calle Capulong into Salvador Mariño Street serving as a reminder for Manileños and Filipinos alike that a life lived in service of others is a life well-lived. It is the hope of the proponent that the renaming of this street will also encourage Filipinos to emulate the life and legacy of the late Honorable Salvador L. Mariño.

In view of the foregoing, the passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT
RENAMING CAPULONG STREET TRAVERSING THE CITY OF MANILA AS
SALVADOR MARIÑO STREET

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Republic of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** In due recognition of the noteworthy accomplishments, invaluable
2 contributions and exceptional public service of Salvador L. Mariño as House
3 Representative for the First District of Manila, Acting Executive Secretary during
4 President Diosdado Macapagal’s Administration, and Secretary for the Department of
5 Justice, Calle Capulong, which forms part of Circumferential Road 2 from Sta. C497.13 (Est
6 deVitas/C2 Br) to Sta. C1396.71 (Mel Lopez Blvd) and serves as the main thoroughfare of
7 Tondo in the City of Manila with a total length of approximately 899.58 l.m, is hereby
8 renamed as Salvador Mariño Street.

10 **SEC. 2.** The Department of Public Works and Highways is hereby directed to place
11 new street signs and appropriate markers; issue the necessary rules, orders, and
12 circulars; and include in its annual budget the funds necessary for the implementation of
13 this Act.

15 **SEC. 3.** This Act shall take effect immediately after its publication in a newspaper
16 of general circulation.
