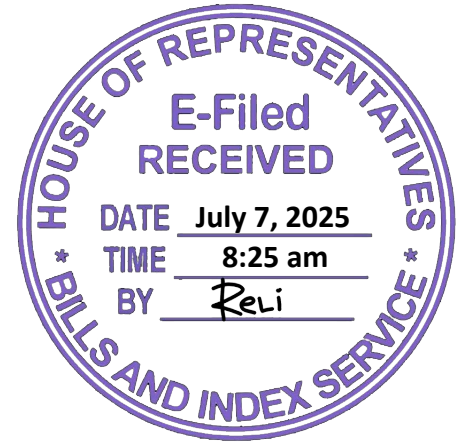

**AN ACT
ESTABLISHING VETERANS MEDICAL CENTERS IN LUZON, VISAYAS AND
MINDANAO**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Philippines owes an immeasurable debt to its veterans, heroes who secured our freedom with their sacrifices. While the existing Veterans Memorial Medical Center stands as a symbol of gratitude, its reach and capacity are limited. Veterans outside Metro Manila face significant challenges accessing specialized care, and the VMMC itself struggles with resource constraints.

This bill proposes establishing Veterans Medical Centers across Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. This expansion will improve accessibility, reduce the burden on the existing VMMC, and enable the development of specialized centers of excellence. It is not just an act of gratitude, but a concrete investment in our veterans' well-being and a testament to our unwavering commitment to those who have bravely served.

In light of the preceding, this bill's approval is fervently sought.

AN ACT
ESTABLISHING VETERANS MEDICAL CENTERS IN LUZON, VISAYAS AND
MINDANAO

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1. Short Title.** — This Act shall be known as the “*Veterans Medical*
2 *Centers Act.*”

3
4 **SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy.** — a) *Recognition of Service and Sacrifice.*
5 — The State recognizes the immense sacrifices made by veterans and their
6 dependents and families in service to our nation. Their dedication and bravery
7 in defending our freedom and upholding our values have secured the peace and
8 prosperity we enjoy today.

10 (b) *Duty to Care.* — It is the fundamental duty of the State to honor and
11 express its profound gratitude to veterans and their dependents and families by
12 providing them with high-quality, accessible, and comprehensive healthcare
13 services that address their unique needs arising from their military service.

15 **SECTION 3. Establishment of Veterans Medical Centers.** — The
16 establishment of one (1) Veterans Medical Center each for Luzon (outside of
17 Metro Manila), Visayas and Mindanao, with a minimum capacity of thirty (30)
18 hospital beds each under the supervision of the Philippine Veterans Affairs Office
19 (PVAO) is hereby mandated.

1 **SECTION 4.** The Secretary of National Defense, in consultation and
2 coordination with the concerned officials of the Department of Interior and
3 Local Government, shall formulate and promulgate the implementing
4 guidelines, rules and regulations necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.
5

6 **SECTION 5. Appropriations.** — The Secretary of Defense shall promptly
7 integrate operationalizing the new Veterans Memorial Medical Centers in Luzon
8 (outside Metro Manila), Visayas, and Mindanao into the Department's
9 programs. Funding for these will be included in the Annual General
10 Appropriations Act.

12 **SECTION 6.** For the purposes of this Act, the term "operationalization" shall
13 include the acquisition of the land on which the hospitals will be established, the
14 construction of the building and other complementary infrastructures, facilities
15 and hospital equipment, as well as the costs for maintenance and personal
16 services for the said facilities.
17

18 **SECTION 7. Repealing Clause.** — All laws, presidential decrees, executive
19 orders, memoranda, circulars, and other issuances, or parts thereof, which are
20 inconsistent with the Act, are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

22 **SECTION 8. Effectivity Clause.** — This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
23 after its publication in the Official Gazette, in a newspaper of general circulation,
24 or on a website provided for by law.
