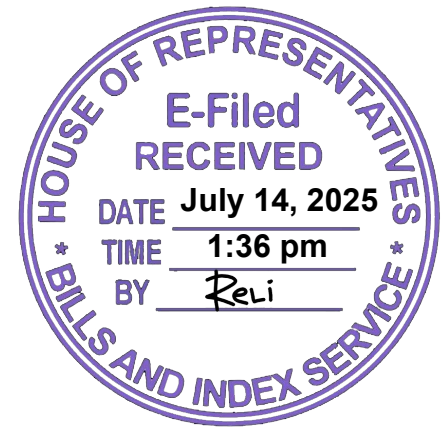

**AN ACT**  
**ESTABLISHING THE NORTHERN ILOILO GENERAL HOSPITAL IN THE**  
**MUNICIPALITY OF SAN DIONISIO, PROVINCE OF ILOILO, AND**  
**APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution states that *“The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them.”*

Furthermore, Article XIII, Section 11 of the same further emphasizes that *“The State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women and children. The State shall endeavor to provide free medical care to paupers.”* Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution, the government must continuously exert efforts in ensuring quality and accessible health care for its people.

This bill seeks to establish a tertiary hospital under the full and direct control, supervision and management of the Department of Health to be known as the Northern Iloilo General Hospital located in San Dionisio, Iloilo.

The establishment of the Northern Iloilo General Hospital will complement and operationalize Republic Act No. 11223 otherwise known as the Universal Health Care Act as it would serve as an End Referral Hospital in the Fifth District of Iloilo<sup>1</sup> catering to the patients of the Gov. Niel D. Tupas Sr. District Hospital, Sara District Hospital, and Jesus M. Colmenares District Hospital, all of which are Level I hospitals. The proposed general hospital will complement the existing district hospitals, expand medical services, and address specialized cases.

The leading causes of referrals and morbidity for the three district hospitals are the following (Hospital Management Office, Province of Iloilo, 2021):

The general hospital will serve indigent patients coming from the Province of Iloilo and from the nearby municipalities of Capiz. The hospital will also decongest regional hospitals all of which are located in the City of Iloilo and bring essential medical health services closer to patients coming from the Fifth District of Iloilo which is the biggest district in the Province of Iloilo in terms of the number of constituents with a population of 472,661 (based on PSA census of 01 May 2020). At present, referred patients coming from the District will have to travel some 2 to 3 hours to go to the city hospitals. Patients coming from the island barangays will have to travel longer since going to the mainland alone will account for half day travel by boat on good weather. There are occasions when due to high occupancy rate, patients will not be readily accommodated or even refused admission.

A similar bill was filed in the Nineteenth Congress and said bill was approved at the Committee level. The bill will contribute in the expansion of public access to quality and affordable health care as well as encourage our people to seek hospital treatments especially now that we are living in the new normal.

In view of the foregoing, the approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

**AN ACT**  
**ESTABLISHING THE NORTHERN ILOILO GENERAL HOSPITAL IN THE**  
**MUNICIPALITY OF SAN DIONISIO, PROVINCE OF ILOILO, AND**  
**APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

**SECTION 1.** There shall be established a general hospital in the Municipality of San Dionisio, Province of Iloilo to be known as the Northern Iloilo General Hospital, which shall be under the direct control and supervision of the Department of Health (DOH).

**SEC. 2.** The DOH shall develop a hospital development plan to define the service capacity, developmental goals and targets of the hospital. Any future increase in bed capacity and upgrading of health care facilities, service capability, and human resource complement shall be based on the hospital development plan.

**SEC. 3.** The site of the hospital shall be in the Municipality of San Dionisio, Province of Iloilo.

**SEC. 4.** The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the Department's program the implementation of this Act. The amount of Nine Hundred Million Pesos (Php 900,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated for the implementation of this Act which shall be included and funded under the General Appropriations Act under the Health Facilities Enhancement Program (HFEP) of the DOH. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for its continued operation shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

**SEC. 5.** If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

**SEC. 6.** All laws, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SEC. 7.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
