DECLARING MANAGONG WATERFALLS LOCATED IN BARANGAY PADIAY, MUNICIPALITY OF SIBAGAT, PROVINCE OF AGUSAN DEL SUR AS AN ECOTOURISM SITE

Explanatory Note

This bill seeks to declare Managong Waterfalls in Barangay Padiay, Municipality of Sibagat, Province of Agusan del Sur as an ecotourism site.

Managong Waterfalls located in Barangay Padiay, Municipality of Sibagat is known to be the biggest and tallest falls in the Province of Agusan del Sur. This hidden beauty is a home of various attractions such as a beautiful mountain scenery, a wide variety of flora and fauna and a deep bluish water in which tourists can enjoy numerous common ecotourism related activities such as swimming, hiking, trekking, mountaineering, kayaking and other wide adventures.

This hidden gem has been considered as a tourist attraction to locals but has never been publicly exposed to other tourists in the Philippines and the world. With the lack of needed development and promotion, the tourism potential of the place has been curtailed. Thus, in order for this gem to be developed and become a fully grown tourism destination, it should be declared as an ecotourism site. The development of Managong Waterfalls into an ecotourism site will not just

enhance its aesthetic value but will also boost local government income and create employment opportunities for the people of Agusan del Sur.

In view of the foregoing, immediate passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT
DECLARING MANAGONG WATERFALLS LOCATED IN BARANGAY PADIAY, MUNICIPALITY OF SIBAGAT, PROVINCE OF AGUSAN DEL SUR AS AN ECOTOURISM SITE

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SEC. 1. The Managong Waterfalls located in Barangay Padiay, Municipality of Sibagat, Province of Agusan del Sur is hereby declared an ecotourism site. Pursuant thereto, its development shall be prioritized and supported by the Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of ecotourism sites.

SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the municipal government of Sibagat shall, in coordination with the DOT, Department of Environment and Natural Resources and concerned agencies of the government, prepare a tourism development plan that shall include the construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate infrastructure and facilities to enhance tourism in the area: Provided, That said development plan shall ensure the preservation and conservation of the natural beauty and resources of the area: *Provided, further,* That the implementation of the tourism development plan shall

be included in the budget of the municipal government of Sibagat.

SEC. 3. The DOT shall assist the municipal government of Sibagat in the implementation of the tourism development plan by providing technical assistance in tourism capacity building. It shall also include the Managong Waterfalls in its national and regional promotion programs.

SEC. 4. The funding for the implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual budget of the municipal government of Sibagat. The DOT may augment such allocation with internally-generated funds.

SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the municipal government of Sibagat shall, in consultation with the DOT and concerned agencies of the government, promulgate rules and regulations to implement this Act.

SEC. 6. If any provision of this Act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 7. All laws, rules, regulations, presidential decrees and other issuances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed repealed or amended accordingly.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
