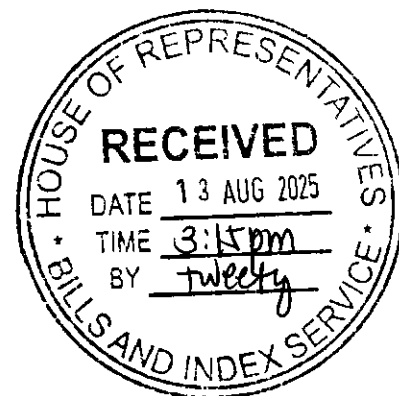

HOUSE BILL NO. 3699



Introduced by Rep. Sittie Aminah Q. Dimaporo and Rep. Imelda Quibranza Dimaporo

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill provides for the construction of a national highway from the junction of the Linamon – Zamboanga Road in Barangay Pigcarangan through Sitio Bucana, Sitio Lamak, Sitio Aloha, Barangay Sagadan, in the Municipality of Tubod through Barangay Sagadan Baroy, Barangay Baroy Daku, to the Municipality of Baroy through Barangay Raw-an, Barangay Gumagamot, Barangay Camalan, Barangay Pacita, Barangay Darumawang Matampay, Barangay Darumawang Ilaya, Barangay El Salvador, in the Municipality of Lala, through Barangay Concepcion, and the Junction of Linamon-Zamboanga National Road at Barangay Lapinig, in Municipality of Kapatagan shall be constructed under the supervision of the Department of Public Works and Highways, to be known as Kapatagan Valley Coastal Road.

Kapatagan is a second class municipality in the Province of Lanao del Norte. According to the 2010 national census, it has a population of 53,916 people. Kapatagan has some rolling hills, flat coastal lands and valley. It has some major rivers that flow to Panguil Bay. During the rainy season, these rivers overflow causing floods which result to destruction of farms and even deaths of farm animals. Because of its distinct topography, the road which the residents of Kapatagan are presently using to transport manufactured goods and agricultural products traverses steep cliffs along the mountain area. This road exposes regular commuters to road slips and landslides.

With these compelling reasons, this Bill seeks the construction of aforementioned road to provide a safer alternate route. It will also facilitate the expeditious delivery of basic services and help promote the quality of life of the people in the area.

In view of the foregoing, approval of this Bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NATIONAL HIGHWAY FROM THE JUNCTION OF LINAMON - ZAMBOANGA ROAD TRAVERSING SITIO BUCANA LOCATED IN BARANGAY PIGCARANGAN, SITIOS LAMAK AND ALOHA, BOTH LOCATED IN BARANGAY POBLACION, ALL LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUBOD, THROUGH BARANGAYS SAGADAN AND BAROY DAKU, BOTH LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAROY, THROUGH BARANGAYS RAW-AN, GUMAGAMOT, CAMALAN, PACITA, DARUMAWANG MATAMPAY, DARUMAWANG ILAYA, AND EL SALVADOR, ALL LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LALA, THROUGH BARANGAY CONCEPCION, AND THE JUNCTION OF LINAMON-ZAMBOANGA NATIONAL ROAD AT BARANGAY LAPINIG, IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF KAPATAGAN, ALL LOCATED IN THE PROVINCE OF LANA DEL NORTE, TO BE KNOWN AS KAPATAGAN VALLEY COASTAL ROAD, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Department of Public Works and Highways is hereby mandated to construct a national highway located in the Province of Lanao del Norte, to be known as the Kapatagan Valley Coastal Road. This highway shall traverse from the junction of the Linamon-Zamboanga Road traversing Sitio Bucana, located in Barangay Pigcarangan, Sitios Lamak and Aloha, both located in Barangay Poblacion, all located in the Municipality of Tubod, through Barangays Sagadan and Baroy Daku, both located in the Municipality of Baroy, through Barangay Raw-an, Gumagamot, Camalan, Pacita, Darumawang

Matampay, Darumawang Ilaya, and El Salvador, all in the Municipality of Lala, through Barangay Concepcion, and the Junction of Linamon-Zamboanga National Road at Barangay Lapinig, in the Municipality of Kapatagan.

SECTION 2. The amount necessary to defray the cost of undertaking and completing the feasibility study and detailed engineering design for the Kapatagan Valley Coastal Road and other activities related thereto shall be included in the General Appropriations Act (GAA). Thereafter, the Secretary of Public Works and Highways shall include in the Department's program the construction of said road, the funding of which shall be included in the GAA.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
