CONGRATULATING THE MEMBERS OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL ESPORTS TEAM SIBOL, MOBILE LEGENDS: BANG BANG SQUAD AND WOMEN’S LEAGUE OF LEGENDS: WILD RIFT SQUAD, FOR WINNING GOLD MEDALS IN THE 31ST SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES HELD IN HANOI, VIETNAM ON MAY 12 TO 23, 2022, AND COMMENDING THEIR RESPECTIVE COACHES AND THE OFFICIALS OF THE PHILIPPINE ESPORTS ORGANIZATION FOR THEIR ABLE MENTORSHIP AND SUPPORT

1 **WHEREAS**, the Philippines is one of the 11 countries that participated in the
2 31st Southeast Asian Games (SEA Games) held in Hanoi, Vietnam on May 12 to 23,
3 2022;

4 **WHEREAS**, the Philippines sent 54 esports athletes who participated in 10
5 sports events in the SEA Games;

6 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine national esports SIBOL Mobile Legends: Bang
7 Bang team won a gold medal and defended their Championship title in the Mobile
8 Legends Bang Bang tournament, after defeating Indonesia in a 3-1 match in the best-
9 of-5 grand finals for the mobile multiplayer online battle arena game;

10 **WHEREAS**, the members of the SIBOL Mobile Legends: Bang Bang team
11 who won a gold medal in the 2022 Hanoi SEA Games are Danerie James A. Del
12 Rosario, Russel Aaron A. Usi, Dexter Louise C. Alaba, Kyle Dominic B. Soto, Jonmar
13 C. Villaluna, Lee Howard B. Gonzales, and Salic A. Imam;

14 **WHEREAS**, the Women’s League of Legends: Wild Rift Tournament featured
15 5 countries: the Philippines, Vietnam, Singapore, Thailand, and Laos;

1 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine national esports all-female team, SIBOL Women’s
2 League of Legends: Wild Rift Squad, became the first women champions in the SEA
3 Games esports history, after winning its first gold medal with a perfect record, winning
4 all six matches and dropping only one game throughout the tournament to complete a
5 dominating performance;

6 **WHEREAS**, the members of the SIBOL’s Female Wild Rift team who won a
7 gold medal in the finals against Singapore with 4-0 match in their debut at the 31st SEA
8 Games are Charize Joyed P. Doble, Rose Ann Marie R. Robles, Christine Ray R.
9 Natividad, April Mae Valiente, Giana Joanne D. Llanes, and Angel Danica Q. Lozada;

10 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino people likewise acknowledge and commend the vital
11 role, unwavering support and assistance of the officials of the Philippine Esports
12 Organization, under the exemplary leadership of its President Brian Lim, and their
13 coaches Kristoffer Ed “Bon Chan” L. Ricaplaza and Aniel Y. Jiandani;

14 **WHEREAS**, it is fitting and timely to congratulate and commend these youth
15 athletes for serving as inspiration not only to the youth but to all Filipinos as well: Now,
16 therefore, be it

17 *Resolved by the House of Representatives*, To congratulate the members of the
18 Philippine national esports team SIBOL, Mobile Legends: Bang Bang Squad and
19 Women’s League of Legends: Wild Rift Squad, for winning gold medals in the 31st
20 Southeast Asian Games held in Hanoi, Vietnam on May 12 to 23, 2022, and commend
21 their respective coaches and the officials of the Philippine Esports Organization for
22 their able mentorship and support.
