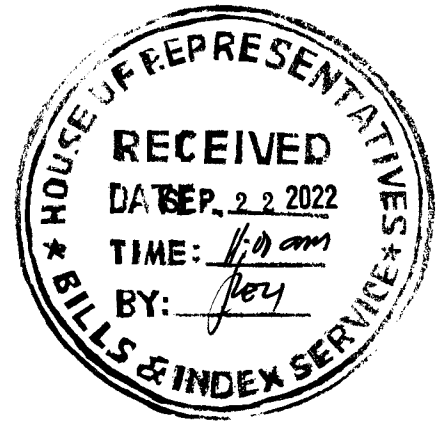

**RESOLUTION ORGANIZING THE PHILIPPINES-BRAZIL
PARLIAMENTARIANS' FRIENDSHIP GROUP**

WHEREAS, developments in the international and regional environment inspire intensification of bilateral and regional relations in order to further broaden global interaction and interdependence;

WHEREAS, recognizing that close cooperation can be the appropriate vehicle to strengthen friendly relations, the Philippines and Brazil have worked for peace and security, economic development, tourism and cultural promotion, and condemnation of racial discrimination and terrorism;


