**RESOLUTION**

**CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE MEMBERS OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL TEAM FOR WINNING TWO (2) SILVER AND TWO (2) BRONZE MEDALS IN THE 2025 WORLD GAMES HELD IN CHENGDU, SICHUAN PROVINCE, PEOPLE’S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, FROM AUGUST 7 TO 17, 2025**

1           **WHEREAS**, the 2025 World Games, a prestigious international multi-sport  
2 event organized by the International World Games Association under the patronage  
3 of the International Olympic Committee, was held in Chengdu, Sichuan Province,  
4 People’s Republic of China, from August 7 to 17, 2025, and participated in by more  
5 than 100 countries, featuring 34 sports, 60 disciplines, and 256 medal events;

6           **WHEREAS**, the Philippines participated in the 12th edition of the World  
7 Games and fielded a delegation of 48 athletes who represented the country in various  
8 disciplines, including billiards, dancesport, esports, jiu-jitsu, wushu, muaythai,  
9 powerlifting, and sambo;

10           **WHEREAS**, the Philippine National Team concluded its 2025 World Games  
11 campaign with a commendable achievement of 2 silver and 2 bronze medals,  
12 underscoring the skill, perseverance, and competitive excellence of Filipino athletes  
13 on the global stage;

1           **WHEREAS**, Jenna Kaila Napolis won the silver medal in the Women’s 52-  
2 kilogram (kg) Jiu-Jitsu *Ne-Waza* event, a discipline that highlights grappling,  
3 control, and submission techniques; her outstanding performance, characterized by  
4 exceptional skill, composure, and fighting spirit, secured the Philippines’ first medal  
5 in the 2025 World Games;

6           **WHEREAS**, Chezka Centeno earned another silver medal in the Women’s 10-  
7 Ball Billiards event, a discipline that demands precision, strategy, and consistency in  
8 pocketing 10 balls in sequence; advancing through the tournament to the finals, she  
9 reaffirmed her standing as one of the country’s most accomplished cue artists;

10           **WHEREAS**, Carlos Baylon, Jr. won the bronze medal in the Men’s 56-kg  
11 Wushu Sanda event, a full-contact combat sport that combines striking and wrestling  
12 techniques, thereby securing the Philippines’ second medal following Kaila Napolis’  
13 silver medal win in jiu-jitsu;

14           **WHEREAS**, Aislinn Agnes Yap won the bronze medal in the Women’s 80-kg  
15 Combat Sambo event, a dynamic martial art combining elements of judo, wrestling,  
16 and striking techniques; her victory contributed to the Philippines’ four-medal finish  
17 at the 2025 World Games;

18           **WHEREAS**, the Filipino people likewise recognize and commend the vital  
19 role and steadfast support of the officials of the Philippine Olympic Committee  
20 (POC), under the leadership of its President, Honorable Abraham “Bambol” N.  
21 Tolentino, together with 2025 World Games Chef de Mission Stephen Arapoc,  
22 President of the Muaythai Association of the Philippines;

23           **WHEREAS**, the outstanding performance of the Philippine National Team in  
24 the 2025 World Games is a testament to their hard work, dedication, and sacrifice,  
25 and serves as an enduring inspiration to future generations of Filipino athletes to  
26 pursue excellence and bring honor to the country on the world stage of sports: Now,  
27 therefore, be it

28           *Resolved by the House of Representatives*, To congratulate and commend  
29 the members of the Philippine National Team for winning two (2) silver and two  
30 (2) bronze medals in the 2025 World Games held in Chengdu, Sichuan Province,  
31 People’s Republic of China, from August 7 to 17, 2025.

32           *Resolved, further*, That copies of this Resolution be furnished to Jenna Kaila  
33 Napolis, Chezka Centeno, Carlos Baylon, Jr., and Aislinn Agnes Yap, as well as to POC  
34 President Abraham “Bambol” N. Tolentino and Chef de Mission Stephen Arapoc.
