**CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
RECONSTITUTING THE PHILIPPINE CONGRESS-BANGSAMORO
PARLIAMENT FORUM, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE VI, SECTION 3 OF REPUBLIC
ACT NO. 11054 OR THE "ORGANIC LAW FOR THE BANGSAMORO
AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO"**

1 **WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 11054 or the "Organic Law for the Bangsamoro
2 Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao", was enacted on 27 July 2018;

3 **WHEREAS**, Article VI, Section 3 of Republic Act No. 11054 mandates the creation of
4 a Philippine Congress-Bangsamoro Parliament Forum for purposes of cooperation and
5 coordination of legislative initiatives;

6 **WHEREAS**, Article XVI, Section 3 of Republic Act No. 11054 provides that the
7 legislative and executive powers in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region during transition
8 shall be vested in the Bangsamoro Transition Authority;

9 **WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 12123 or "An Act Resetting the First Regular Elections
10 in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, Amending for the Purpose,

1 Section 13, Article XVI of Republic Act No. 11054, as amended, Otherwise Known as the
2 ‘Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao’”, was enacted
3 on 19 February 2025, resetting the first regular election for the Bangsamoro Government to 13
4 October 2025, with the term of office of elected officials commencing at noon on 30 October
5 2025;

6 **WHEREAS**, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 12123 provides that the Bangsamoro
7 Transition Authority shall continue to serve as the interim government, and that its interim
8 members shall serve until their successors have been elected and qualified in an automated
9 election;

10 **WHEREAS**, to support the effective implementation of Republic Act No. 11054, there
11 is an urgent need to establish and convene the Philippine Congress-Bangsamoro Parliament
12 Forum;

13 **WHEREAS**, under Section 1, Article VI of the 1987 Constitution, the Congress of the
14 Philippines consists of both the Senate and the House of Representatives;

15 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF**
16 **REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING**, To reconstitute the Philippine
17 Congress-Bangsamoro Parliament Forum, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3 of Republic Act
18 No. 11054 or the “Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim
19 Mindanao”.

20 **RESOLVED, FURTHER**, That the Senate of the Philippines and the House of
21 Representatives shall each constitute a five (5)-member panel to represent their respective
22 chambers in the Philippine Congress-Bangsamoro Parliament Forum, with members to be
23 designated by the Senate President and the Speaker of the House, respectively.

24 **RESOLVED, FINALLY**, That the minority in both the Senate and the House of
25 Representatives shall each be allotted at least two (2) seats in the Philippine Congress–
26 Bangsamoro Parliament Forum.
