WITHDRAWAL OF ELECTION OF MAJORITY MEMBERS

On motion of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body approved the withdrawal of the election of Reps. Emmarie “Lolypop” Ouano-Dizon and Rosemarie Conejos Panotes as vice-chairpersons of the Committee on Ways and Means.

ELECTION OF REPRESENTATIVE YAP (ERIC) AS VICE-CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

On another motion of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body affirmed the election of Rep. Eric Go Yap as vice-chairperson of the Committee on Ways and Means vice Representative Ouano-Dizon.

SUSPENSION OF SESSION

On motion of Representative Defensor, the Chair suspended the session at 4:20 p.m.

RESUMPTION OF SESSION

The session was resumed at 4:21 p.m.

PRIVILEGE HOUR

With leave of the House, on successive motions of Rep. Francisco “Kiko” A. Barzaga, there being no objection, the Chair declared a Privilege Hour and thereafter, recognized Rep. Rolando M. Valeriano for his privilege speech.

At this juncture, Deputy Speaker Singson-Meehan relinquished the Chair to Deputy Speaker Ortega.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE VALERIANO

Representative Valeriano brought to the fore the issue surrounding the war on drugs of the previous administration, particularly the alleged involvement of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) in drug recycling, staged operations, and other illegal activities instead of dismantling drug syndicates. He said that the deeply rooted system of abuse that thrived at PDEA was uncovered by the Quad Committee

(QuadCom) during the 19th Congress based on the testimonies of informants, some of whom, he said, had gone missing, as well as from the statements of former PDEA officials.

Pointing out that the systemic pattern of abuse within PDEA is disturbing, frustrating, and embarrassing, Representative Valeriano highlighted the following revelations and practices within PDEA and other operatives of the police force, to wit: (1) rampant drug recycling in PDEA which, he said, was even admitted by former PDEA Director General Aaron Aquino during a Senate hearing in 2019; (2) fake buy-bust operations involving convicted PDEA agents in Dumaguete City; (3) shootout between PDEA and the Philippine National Police-National Capital Region Police Office in 2021, which exposed deep failures in coordination and trust; and (4) emergence of “ninja cops” who were targeted to be killed for worth ₱1 million. He questioned the silence on the issues surrounding PDEA, especially when similar actions by police officers previously drew public outrage. With the QuadCom disbanded, he said that investigations were left unfinished, and critical issues remain unresolved, hence, the need for Congress to enact the proper legislation, not just to conduct investigations.

In urging Congress not to merely expose any wrongdoings but institutionalize the safeguards to prevent them from recurring, Representative Valeriano urged the Body to revive the QuadCom or form a special oversight committee dedicated to (1) conduct a full, independent, and transparent investigation into the extent of the PDEA’s involvement in drug recycling and illegal activities; (2) audit the narcotics inventory and chain of custody for the past 10 years; (3) subpoena former agency heads and field agents for testimony; and (4) hold those who facilitated the abuses accountable to the full force of the law.

Finally, Representative Valeriano urged his colleagues, as Representatives of the people, not to ignore the issue, stressing that it is a fight for truth, not politics. He added that inaction would make lawmakers complicit in past abuses, and stressed that accountability and transparency are the first steps toward national healing.

MOTION OF REPRESENTATIVE BARZAGA

As Representative Barzaga moved to refer the privilege speech of Representative Valeriano,

Rep. Roger Gaviola Mercado sought recognition from the Chair to raise clarificatory questions.

On motion of Rep. Anna Victoria Veloso-Tuazon, the Chair recognized Representative Mercado for his interpellation.

INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE MERCADO

Representative Mercado initially commended Representative Valeriano for raising an important and timely issue. After citing the constitutional provision on public trust in public service, Representative Mercado opined that thinking about how to resolve the persistent and rampant problem of graft and corruption could be a good start.

Representative Valeriano responded that such concerns would be addressed as part of the QuadCom investigation. Representative Mercado then expressed hope that public officers recognize the impact of graft and corruption in the government and strive to set an example of good governance.

REFERRAL OF PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE VALERIANO

On motion of Representative Barzaga, there being no objection, the Body approved to refer the privilege speech of Representative Valeriano and the interpellation thereon to the Committee on Rules for its appropriate action.

TERMINATION OF PRIVILEGE HOUR

Subsequently, there being no other Members who wished to avail themselves of the Privilege Hour, on motion of Representative Barzaga, there being no objection, the Chair terminated the Privilege Hour.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

Thereupon, upon the request of Rep. Brian Poe, the Chair recognized the presence in the Session Hall of the guests of Rep. Arturo B. Robes, including Mr. Jerrold Pete Mangliwan, an Asian Para Games gold and silver medalists, and 2024 Paris Paralympics finalist; as well as those of Reps. Ramon C. Nolasco and Baby Aline Vargas-Alfonso.

Likewise, upon the request of Rep. Jeyzel Victoria C. Yu, the Chair acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of the guests of Speaker Ferdinand Martin G. Romualdez, and Reps. Yedda Marie K. Romualdez and Jude A. Acidre.
